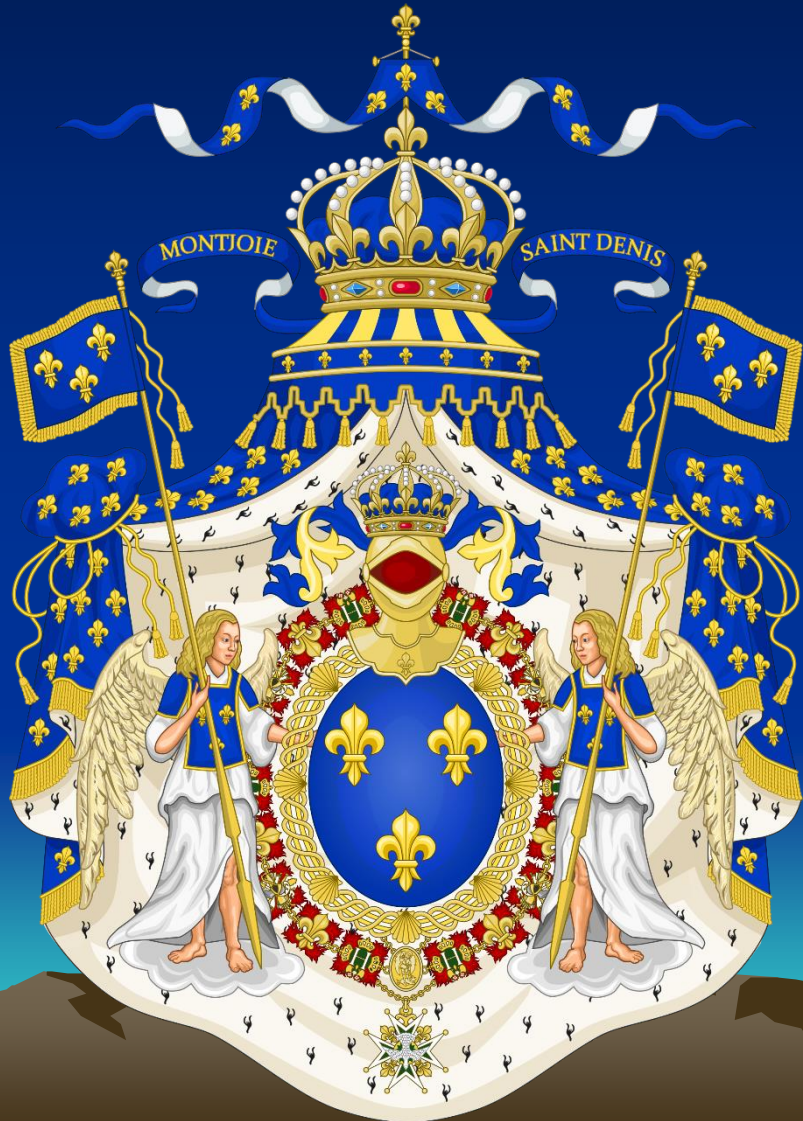

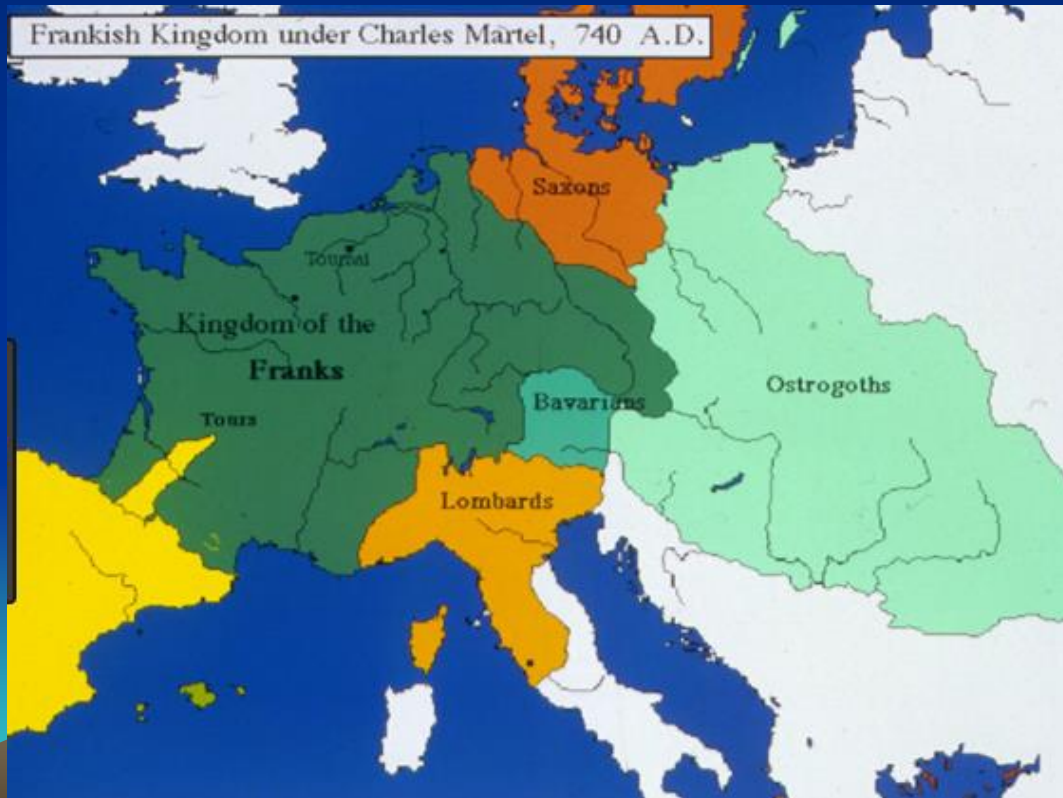

Clovis [Chlodweg] (465-511), became King of the Salian Franks in Tournai He founded the unified Frank monarchy and became the only king of the whole Gaul. His baptism c. 496 made him the first "Barbarian" king to adopt Roman Catholicism as personal religion

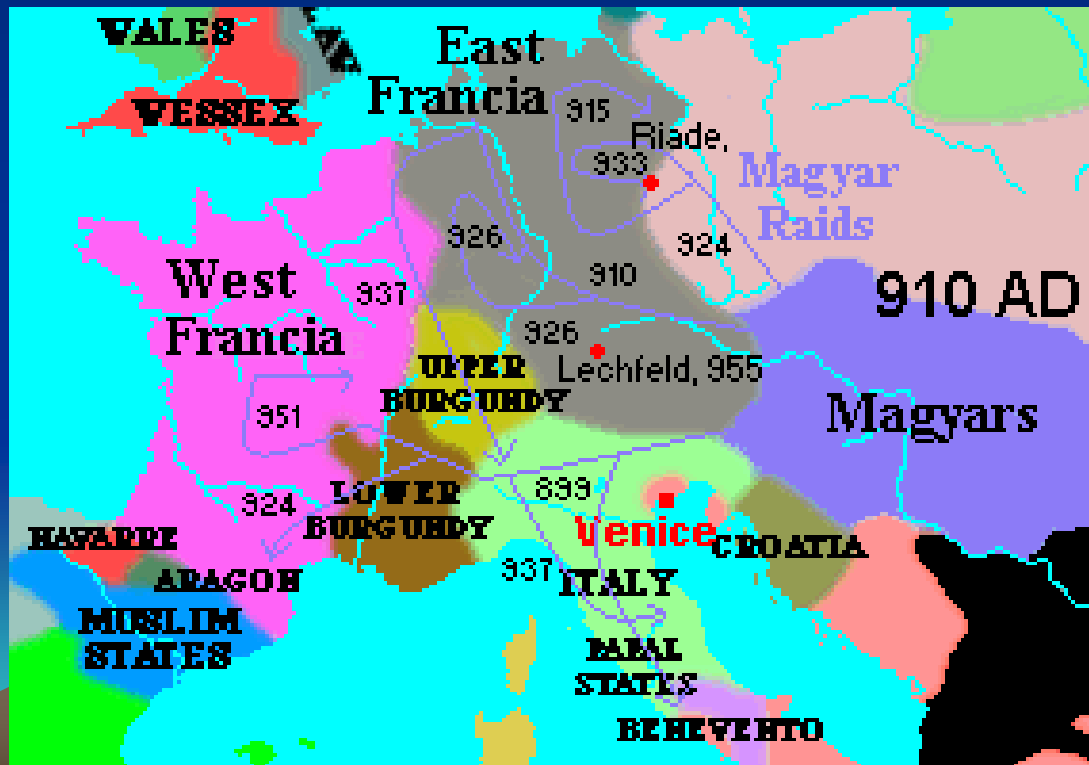

Reuben during King Clovis' reign occupied a vast area of Central Europe, encompassing other tribes such as Judah, Zebulon and others

Shortly after Clovis, the vast kingdom of the Franks would divide into the West Franks, eventually becoming France and The East Franks Germany

The Western Franks began to assimilate the Gallic Latin based language while the Eastern Franks continued to speak their native Germanic language. Eventually the land dominated by the Western Franks became what is today known as France while the Eastern Franks became part of what is today known as Germany (Pharez Judah)

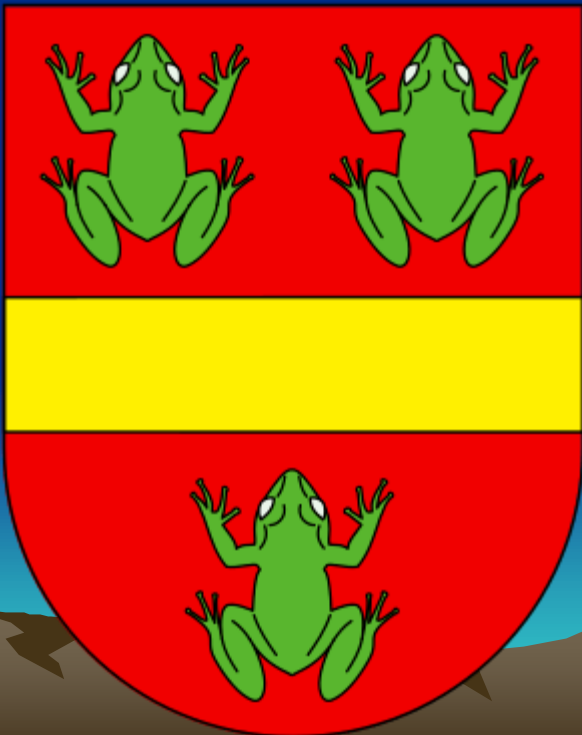

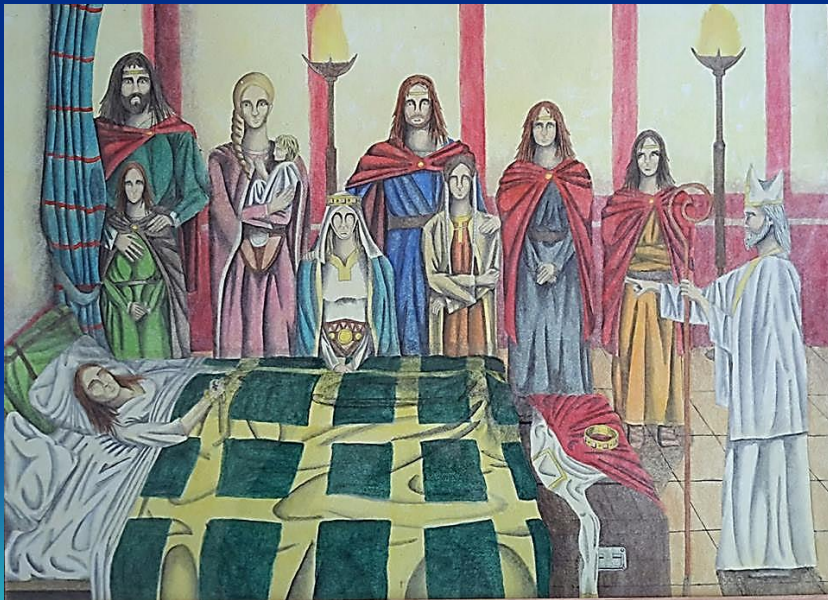

Illustration left depicts Clovis, after being baptised a Christian, receiving his Fleur-de-lis banner, replacing the evil frogs (toads). Some say it was because the French objected to being called frogs by people in other lands.

After Clovis' death, Reuben's Kingdom was divided among his four sons Thierry I (King of Austrasia), Clodomir (king of Orléans), Clotaire I (king of Neustria), and Childebert (king of Paris).

What Happened To Reuben?

Clovis was the first king of the Merovingian dynasty. During his reign Clovis ruled most of what is today France and large parts of Germany etc. Let their be no doubt Reuben was then the strongest Israelite tribe in Europe. After Clovis died his kingdom was divided between his 4 sons as Reuben see **Gen 46:9.**

What Happened To Reuben?

Despite his turbulent emotions Reuben did have some leadership qualities.

About 751 AD Pepin the powerful Mayor of the Palace deposed the last king of the Merovingian dynasty and became the king himself. He assumed the kingship with the blessing of the Pope. Pepin began the Carolingian dynasty of kings. In 768 AD Pepin's son Charlemagne became the king of the powerful Frankish kingdom.

Carolingian Dynasty

Charlemagne divided his empire into regions governed by counts. *Missi dominici* were sent into the kingdom as his direct representatives



What Happened To Reuben?

Despite his turbulent emotions Reuben did have some leadership qualities.



The divisions between the French Reubenite Franks and the Pharez Franks of Germany became permanent. In 987 the French nobles rejected the rightful Carolingian claimant to the French crown and gave the crown to Hugh Capet, the Duke of France who founded the Capetian dynasty. Later the Capetian kings made Paris the capital of France.

What Happened To Reuben?



The Vatican obviously knows France's true status as Reuben as she refers to France as her "First Son", just like the Vatican also refers to England as "Mary's Dowry", knowing that Mary was born and buried in England.

The Sun and the Moon is used in scripture as a metaphor for Israel, and Reuben being the elder son for this reason took the sun as an emblem, although as always, the enemy takes Israel's symbol's and turns them into heathen objects of worship!

Confident in Ability to Rule

- Young king supremely confident in ability to rule
- When Mazarin died, 18-year-old Louis declared he would run government himself – takes reigns of government in 1661
- “I am the state,” he declared



Louis XIV epitomised the traits of Reuben. He was the longest reigning monarch of any European Royal House – 72 years. He was also known as Louis the God-Given (*Louis Dieudonné*), Louis the Great (*Louis le Grand*) or the Sun King (*Roi Soleil*),

What Happened To Reuben?



Louis XIV was enthroned as king when only 4 year old on the 14th May, 1643 under the regency of his mother, Anna of Austria). However, in actuality during this period the power was welded by a government minister, Cardinal Mazarin. Louis XIV's with his Reubenite trait of vanity and lustfulness are well known.

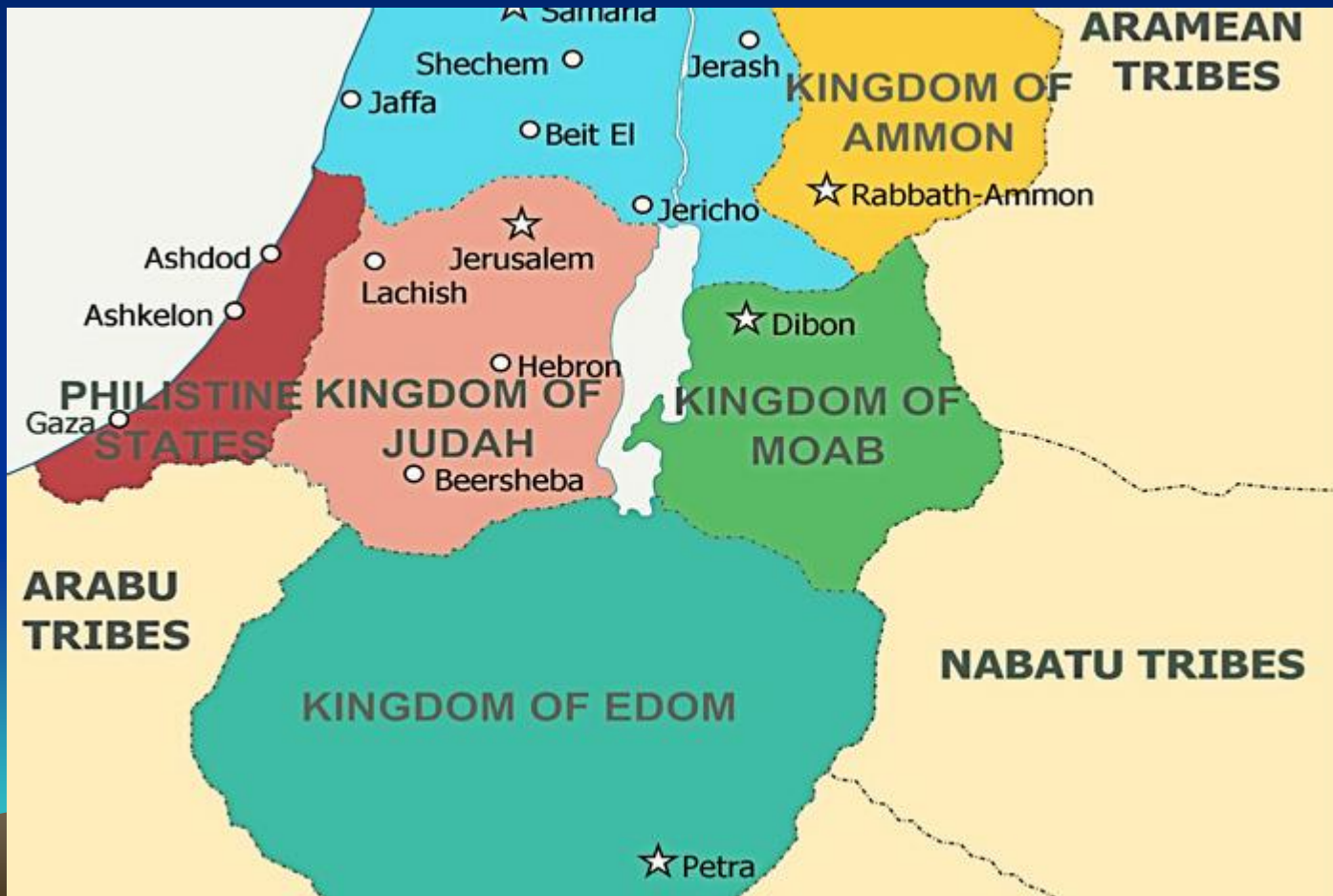

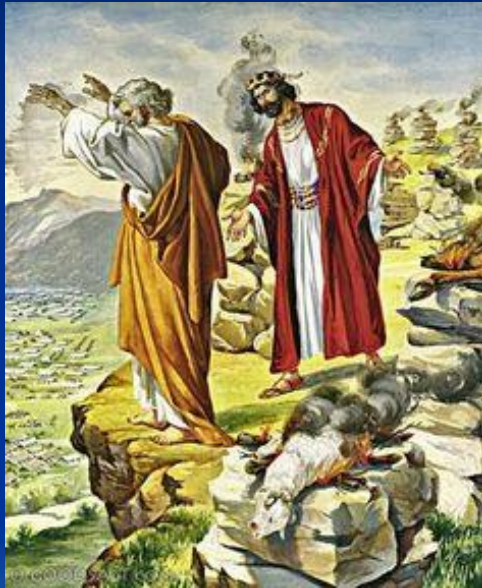

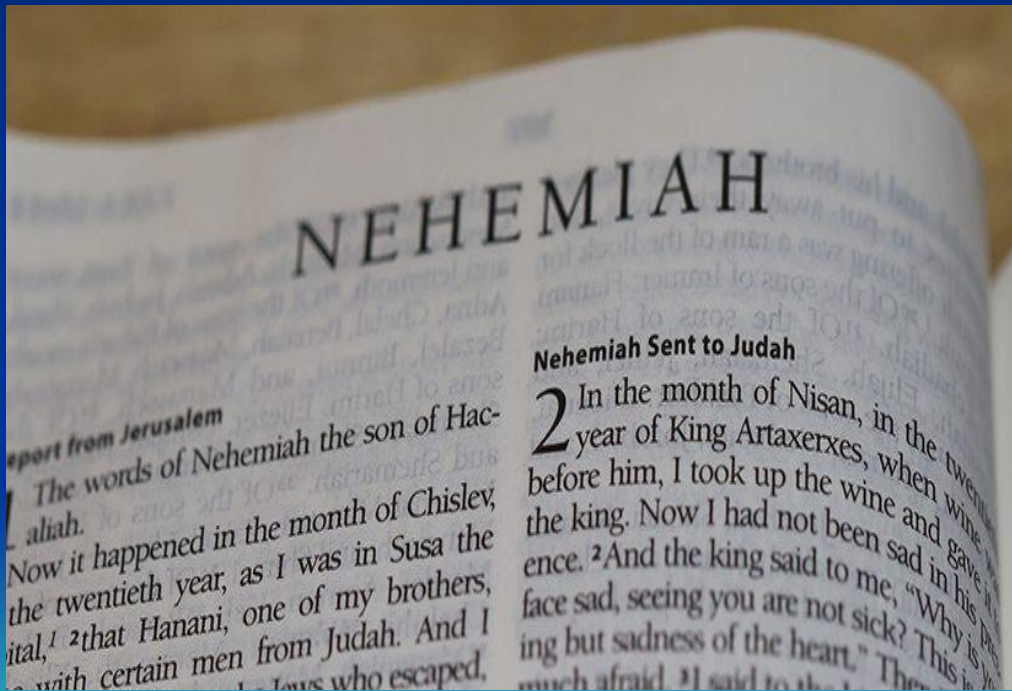

Old stories, history and folk-law can be very astonishing. For example there was a certain church historian by the name of Caesar Baronius who was employed by the Vatican in 1596. It was there in the Vatican library, that he found an ancient manuscript, which he referred to in his book titled *“Annales Ecclesiastici”*

In it he describes how a group known as “friends of the Lord”, who were in a boat, without a rudder or sail that had been blown by the wind over the Mediterranean; came aground on the shores of an area known today as Marseilles....

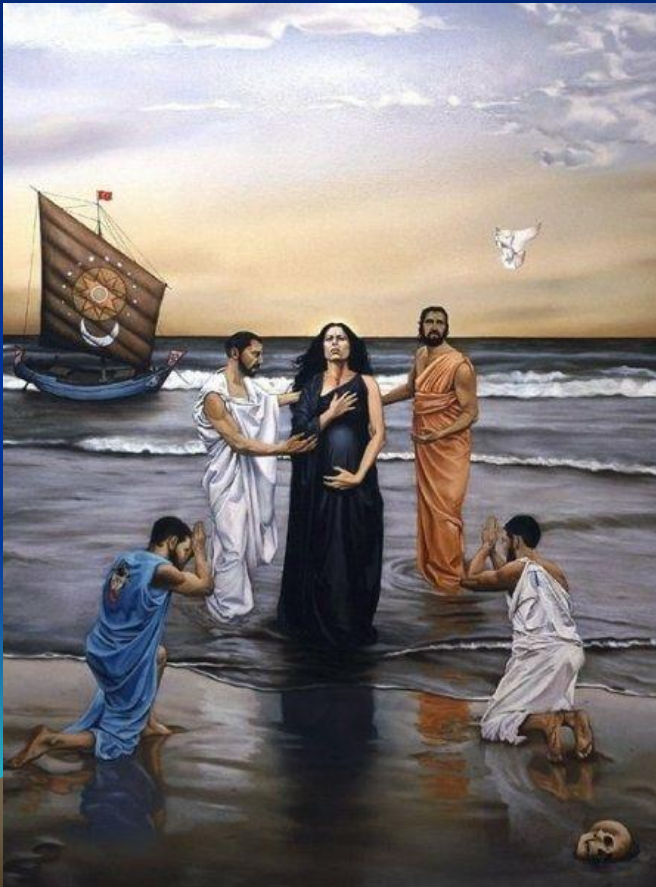
What can be gleaned from ancient documents about Reuben?



....In the year AD 35. this group was exiled in this boat by the Sanhedrin in Jerusalem; with the intent of causing their deaths because they feared these people. They assumed they would have no chance in the stormy sea!...

The French poet Mistral named the group out of this ship as: Maria (wife of Kleopas), Maria Magdalena, Martha and her maid servant Marcella, Lazarus, Joseph of Arimathea and Jesus' mother, Trophimus, Maximus, Cleon, Europius, Sidonius also known as Martialis (nephew of Stefanus and Saturnis).

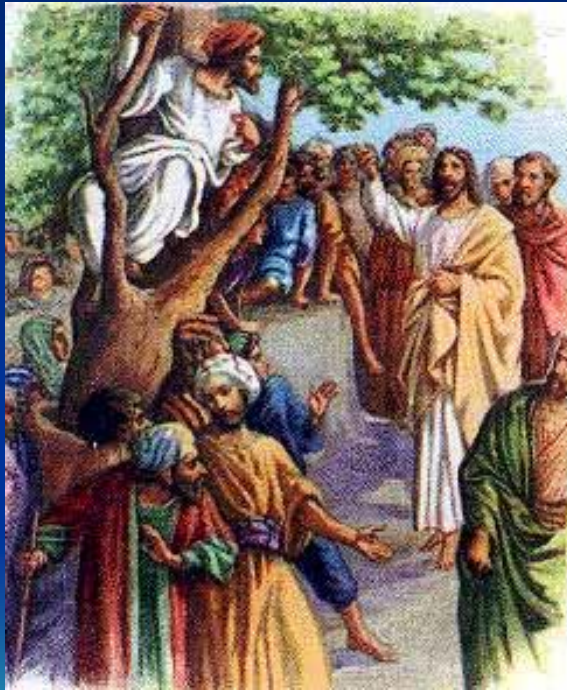
Martha and Marcella preached in Arles, in Avignon and along the Rhone.

According to the founding legend, Rocamadour is named after the founder of the ancient sanctuary, Saint Amator, identified with the Biblical Zacchaeus, the tax collector of Jericho mentioned in Luke 19:1-10, and the husband of St. Veronica, who wiped Jesus' face on the way to Calvary.

Driven out of Palestine by persecution, St. Amadour and Veronica embarked in a frail skiff and, guided by an angel, landed on the coast of Aquitaine, where they met Bishop St. Martial, another disciple of Christ who was preaching the Gospel in the south-west of Gaul.

What Happened To Reuben?

Gaul (An Ancient Name of France) Its Origin



Gaul is derived from Hebrew meaning “the round”. However in Babylon it referred to the Moon. In English it is a round protrusion on a tree. Reuben being the eldest, took the symbol of the Sun, which often symbolically represents Israel.

What Happened To Reuben?

Gaul (An Ancient Name of France) Its Origin



It is the root (Gal or Gula) enters into all words which imply rotundity of shape and motion – so also of rolling. The rolling of stones together is in Scripture called Gal-eed..

Gilead (Various spellings) means precisely such heaps of stones as the French and British tumuli. “Jacob said to his brethren, Gather stones; and they took stones, and made an heap... And Laban said, This heap is a witness between me and thee this day. Therefore was the name of it called Galeed.” Genesis 31:48

What Happened To Reuben?

Origin of The Name Reuben



Reuben: *See, a son!* And when the LORD SAW that Leah was hated, he opened her womb: but Rachel was barren. And Leah conceived, and bare A SON, and she called his name REUBEN (r'eu-ven – see, (a) son: for she said, Surely the LORD hath LOOKED upon my affliction; now therefore MY HUSBAND (my man) will love me Gen 29:31-32.

Origin of The Name Reuben



REUBEN'S COAT OF ARMS: A MAN.
There are two traditional emblems for the tribe of Reuben. Water, because he would be unstable as water (Gen 49:3-4) and 'a handsome man' because of his name: See a son! Reuben! The Man is sometimes substituted for the mandrake plant!

This manliness can be seen among the French, as so many of them are very chauvinistic. Being full of being French, great pride in self and in French language and culture

Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine

Reuben was the firstborn and in principle had the right to all the blessings promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. He was a man and he was the firstborn. Reuben was once destined to be the future leader of the tribe. This was not to be, due to sexual indiscretion!

Reuben is a precocious nine year old when he finds dudayim, love-fruit, in the field (left). Apparently he knows about the use of the fruit and gives the love-fruit (mandrakes) to his mother Leah. In the Near East power was ascribed to Mandrakes, to arouse sex appeal and increase fertility. The Hebrew name duday – from dûd, to love - reflects the use of the mandrake.

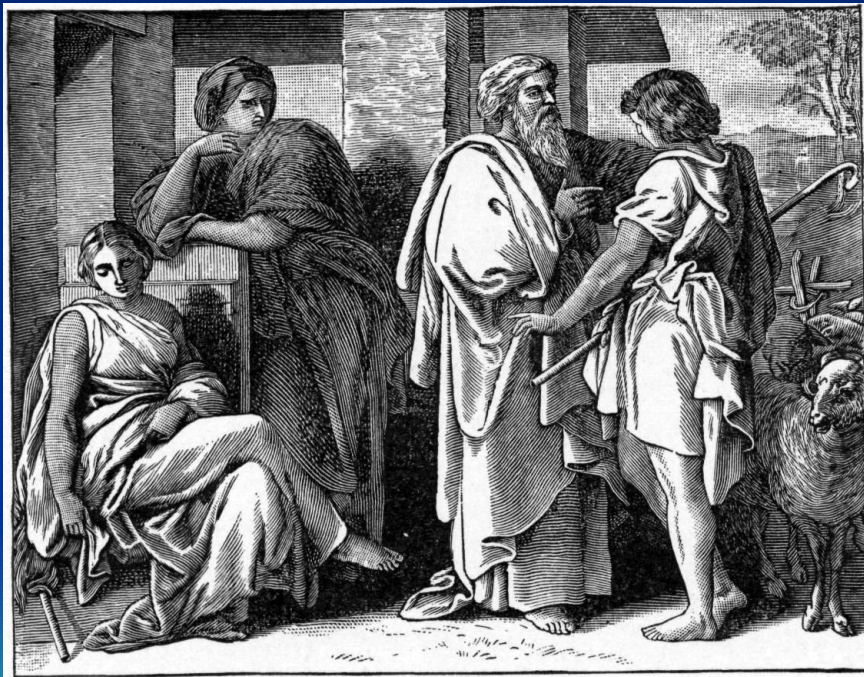


Leah swapped the love-fruit for sex with her own husband, who was with Rachel most of the time apparently. From this encounter Issachar was born

Through deceit by Laban Jacob ends up with two women. Leah and Rachel battle for Jacob's favours. This is the first love triangle, from this love triangle Reuben is born. Rachel has Jacob's love, but Leah has fertility, reproduction.

REUBEN who is a first result of that love triangle, causes himself a new love triangle with his sexual adventure. After Rachel's death he has sex with Bilhah, his father's concubine.

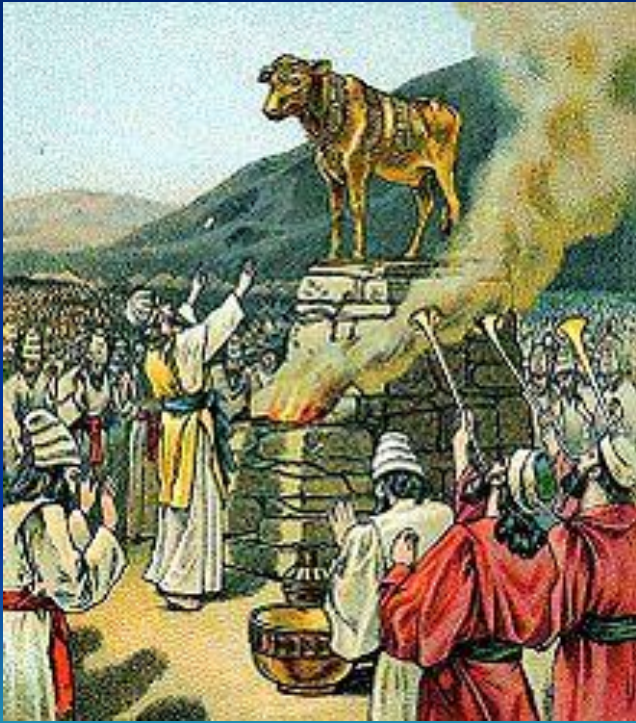

The Golden Calf

The Reubenites joined the sex and dance around the Golden Calf. The tribe of Levi abstained and thus got the priesthood. Reuben also joined in the orgy for Baal-Peor in the fields of Moab. Phinehas, of Levi, showed positive behaviour ... Reuben just joined in. The Reubenites missed their chances to make a difference.

Over the past 500 years, there has been more acceptance of the love triangle, of having a mistress, a lover, in France, than anywhere else.

From the reign of Louis XIV, the term has been applied, both in translation ("official mistress") and in the original French, to refer to the main mistress of any monarch or prominent man when his relationship with her is not clandestine.

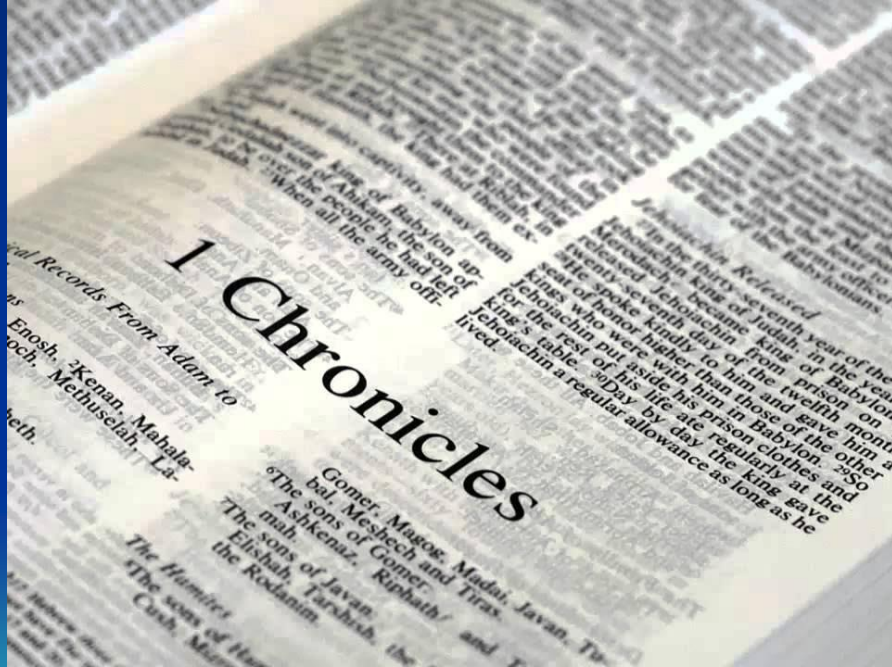

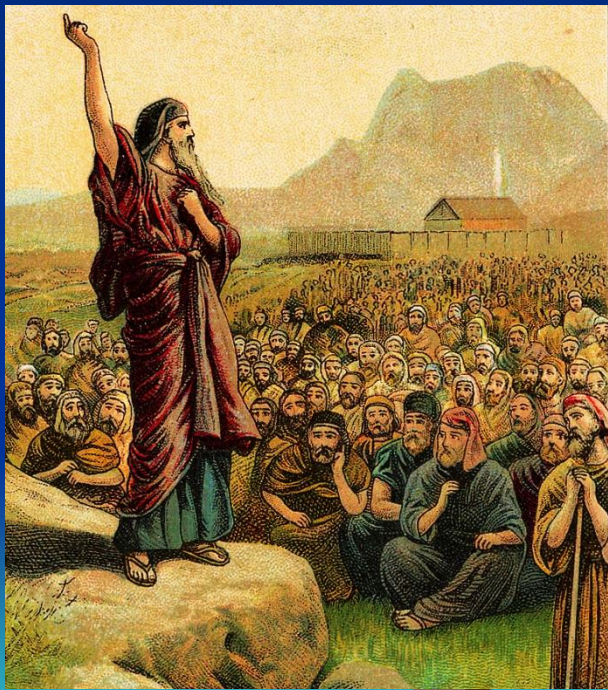

**The Ten Tribes
Going into Exile**

Reubenites never distinguished themselves in a positive way. The tribe of Reuben murmured in the desert, just like the rest of Israel; the Reubenite spy also brought back a bad report; Reuben belonged to the 10 rebelling tribes of Jeroboam and also belonged to the 10 unfaithful lost tribes, which went into the Assyrian exile.

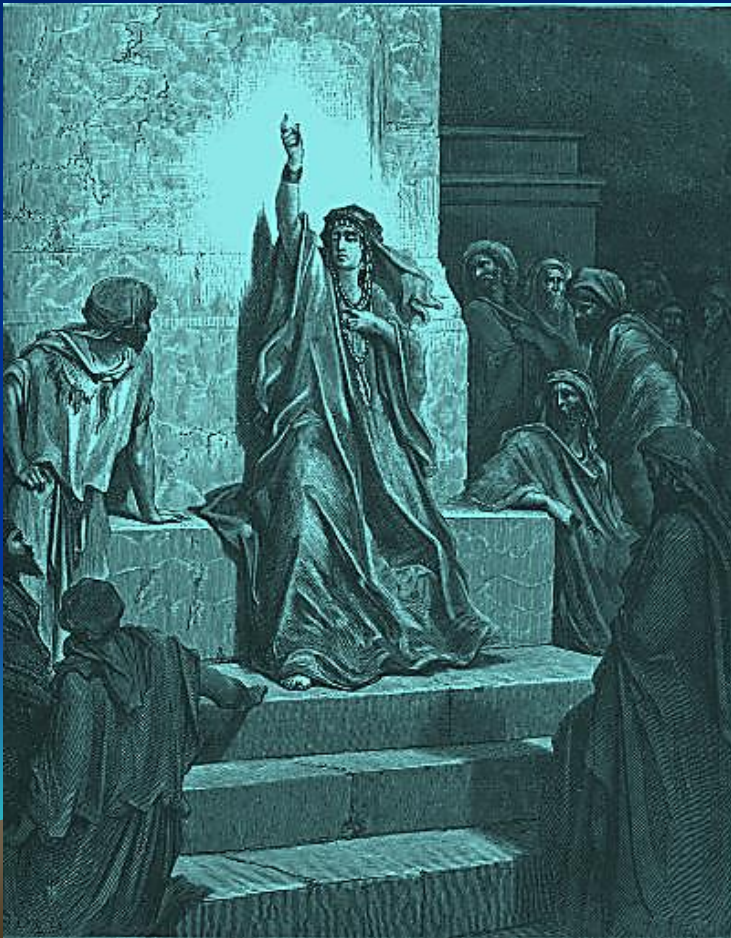


Transjordan Today

Their request to live in Transjordan (Moab) caused them to live far away from the other Israelites. Their western border was the Jordan and the Dead Sea, on the south they bordered Moab and the desert in the east. It was only in the north that they bordered another Israelite tribe Gad.

Consequently they kept to themselves in the time of Deborah and Barak: ... For the divisions of Reuben there were great thoughts of heart. Why abodest thou among the sheepfolds, to hear the bleatings of the flocks? For the divisions of Reuben there were great searchings of heart (Judg 5:15-16).

French history and French spirit have displayed a spirit of rebellion, independence and revolt, over the past 250 years. The Gauls (Celts) also had a very independent spirit at the time of Julius Caesar (Left)

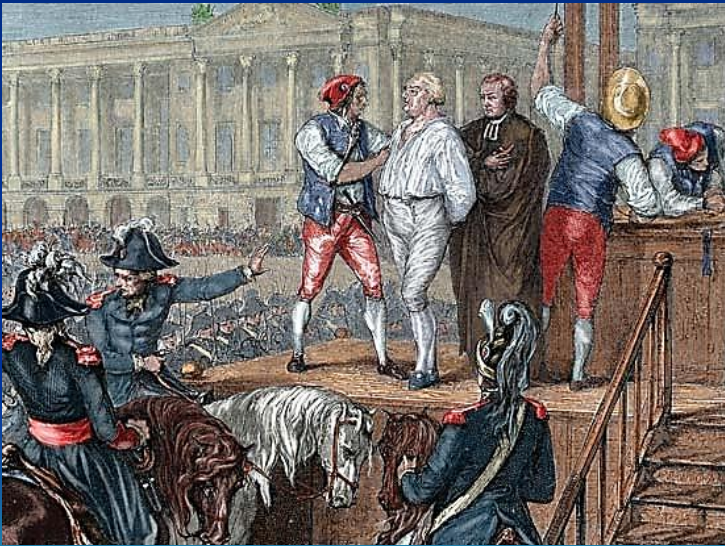

Independence and rebelliousness of the French is well-known. Without going into detail: the strikes of May '68, the Commune of Paris, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th République, 14 juillet, 1789, the Bastille, la Marseillaise, the revolutionary years of 1830, 1848, 1870, guillotine, générale de Gaulle, Force de frappe, the leaving of NATO command.

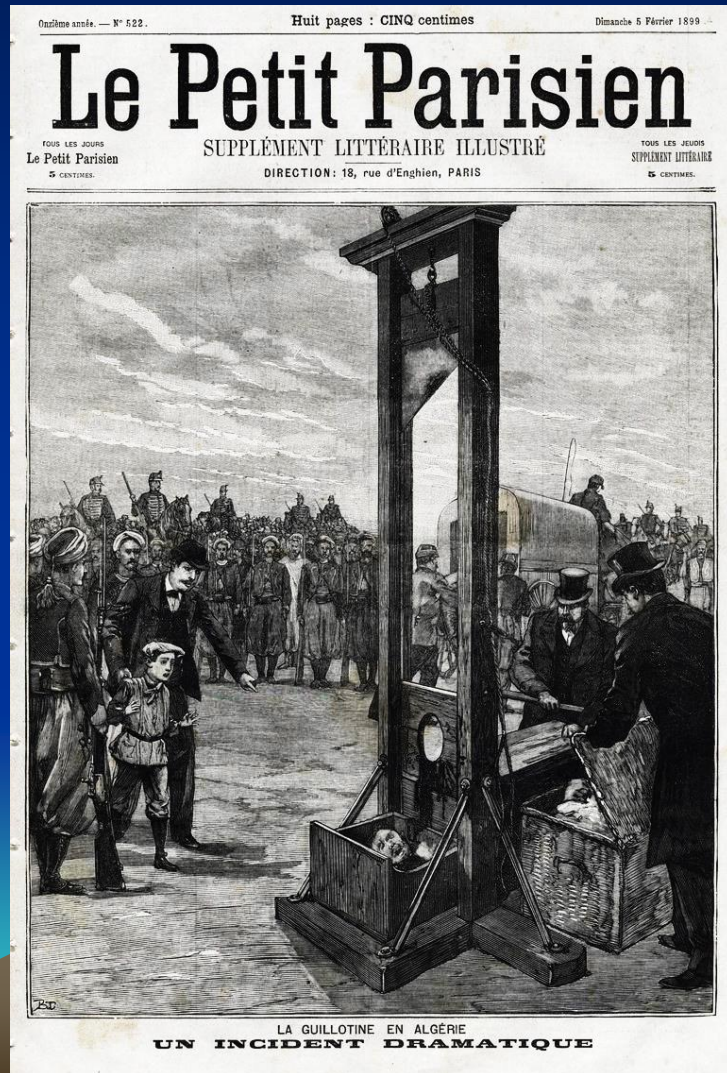

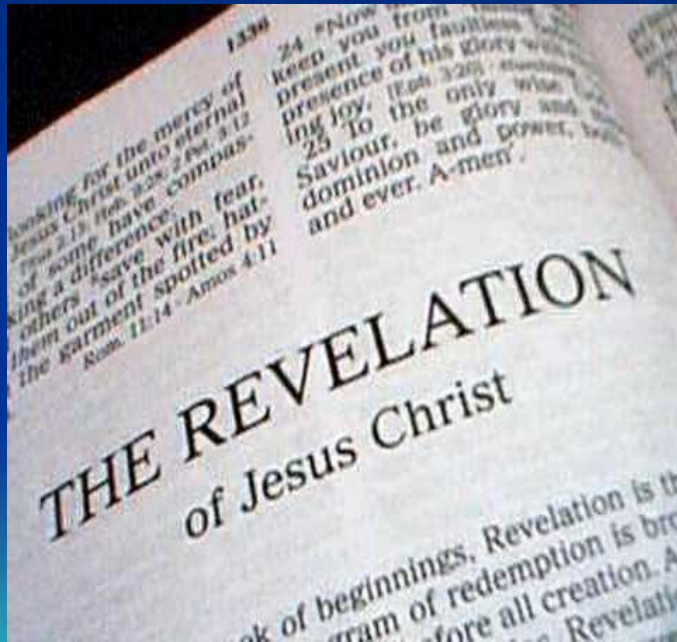

Vast numbers of revolutionary executions were by guillotine developed Joseph-Ignace Guillotine, a doctor, together with German engineer Tobias Schmidt, built a prototype for the guillotine. Schmidt recommended using an angled blade as opposed to a round one.

The French are well known for their instability. The expression “French leave”, that means so many French discharge themselves and disappear and go back home, for example, between 1875 and 1945 there were 100 changes of cabinet. That is to say each cabinet lasted on average for only 8 months!

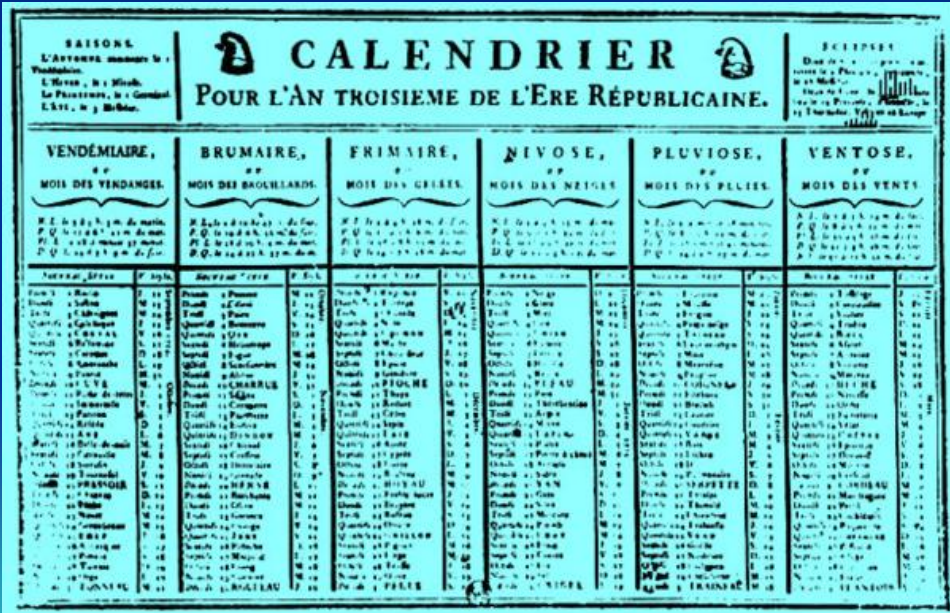

Many French plans backfired. Louis XIV wanted France to be vast and great and wanted the Rhine to be the national border of France. He waged war all his life. Many of the plans of the Revolution (1789) came to nothing, under Jewish influence, the French even tried to abolish the week. They split up the months into three decades (10 days), after twelve months of 30 days there were 5 loose days to finish off the year.

This Republican French Calendar was in use from 1793 to 1805. They also invented decimal time, another impracticable plan. The day would have 10 hours, each hour 100 minutes and each minute a 100 seconds.

Napoleon eventually got rid of most of the fruitless plans of the revolution. He fought for the glory of himself and France by conquering Europe. Also unprofitable, in the end all conquests were lost to France. What remained was the 5 million dead of all the Napoleonic wars.
