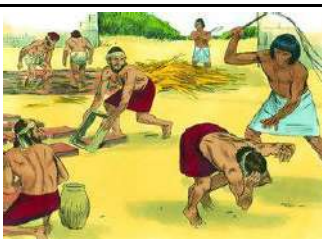

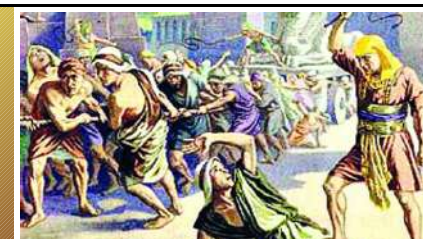


Exodus 3:4 Yahweh called unto Moses out of the midst of the burning bush...

Exodus 12:1 And Yahweh spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying,
12:2 This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.

12:3 Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:

12:5 Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:

12:6 And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.



12:7 And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

12:8 And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it.

Exodus 12:36 And Yahweh gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they gave them what they asked. And they spoiled the Egyptians.

12:37 And the children of Israel journeyed from Rameses to Succoth, about six hundred thousand men on foot, beside children.

Deuteronomy 4:14 And Yahweh commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and judgments, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go over to possess it.

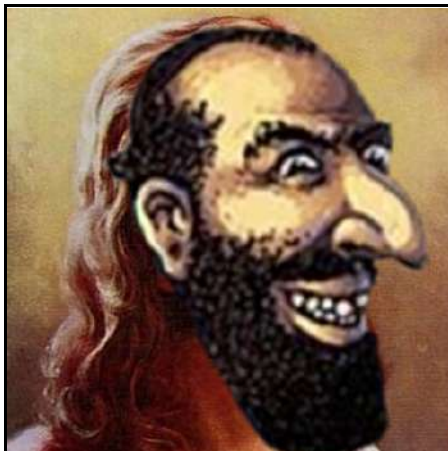

You cannot serve God and mammon.











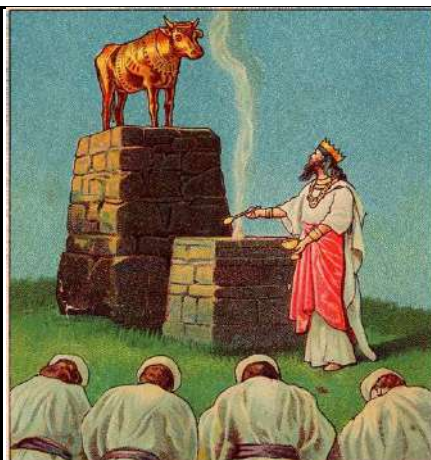

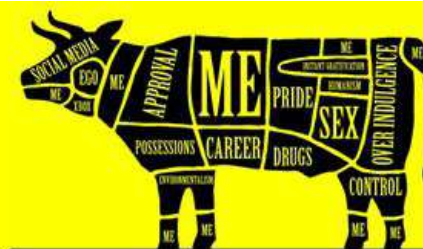
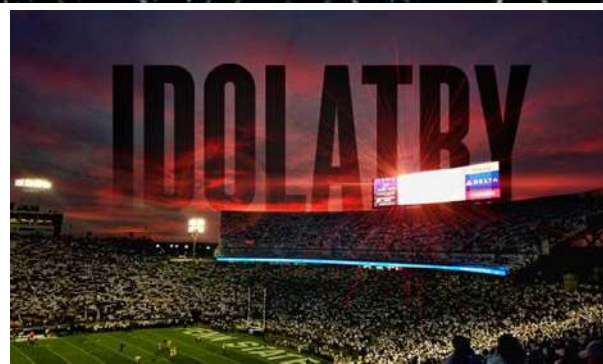


THE 2ND COMMANDMENT

THE 3RD COMMANDMENT

GOD's last name is not "DAMMIT"

"You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name."

Exodus 20:7 (NIV)

James 5:12 But above all things, my brethren, swear not (vainly), neither by heaven, neither by the earth, neither by any other oath: but let your yea be yea; and your nay, nay; lest ye fall into condemnation.

Job 2:9 Then said his wife unto him, Do you still retain your integrity? curse God, and die.

2:10 But he said unto her, You speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.



THE JEWS SWEAR AN OATH **NOT** TO KEEP THEIR OATHS

The Official Translation of the Kol Nidre Oath

"All Vows, obligations, oaths, anathemas, whether called konam, konas, or by any other name, which we may vow, or swear, or pledge or whereby we are bound, from this Day of Atonement unto the next, whose happy coming we await, we do repent. May they be deemed absolved, forgiven, annulled, and void and made of no effect; they shall not bind us or have power over us. The Vows shall not be reckoned vows; the obligations shall not be obligatory; nor the oaths be oaths."

The 'letter' of the law.

Matthew 5:33 Again, ye have heard that it hath been said by them of old time, You shalt not forswear yourself, but shalt perform unto Yahweh your oaths:

The 'spirit' of the law.

5:34 But I say unto you, Swear not (vainly) at all; neither by heaven; for it is God's throne:

5:35 Nor by the earth; for it is His footstool: neither by Jerusalem; for it is the city of the great King.

5:36 Neither shalt you swear by your head, because you canst not make one hair white or black.

5:37 But let your communication be, Yea, yea; Nay, nay: for whatsoever is more than these cometh of evil.

The sense is of rash swearing, about trivial matters. The law respecting oaths forbade the people to perjure themselves, or to swear falsely.

Yahshua had no reference to judicial oaths, or oaths taken in a court of justice. It was merely the foolish and wicked habit of swearing in private conversation; of swearing on every occasion and by everything, that He condemned. Jesus Himself did not refuse to take an oath in a court of law.

THE 4TH COMMANDMENT

REMEMBER THE SABBATH DAY,
TO KEEP IT HOLY.



Nehemiah 13:15 In those days saw I in Judah some treading wine presses on the Sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and loading donkeys with wine, grapes, and figs, and all kinds of burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the Sabbath day: So I warned them in the day wherein they sold.

13:16 And men of Tyre also therein, bringing in fish, and all kinds of goods, and sold them on the Sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

13:17 Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said to them, "What evil thing is this that you are doing, profaning the Sabbath day?"

13:18 Did not your fathers thus, that our God brought all this evil upon us, and upon this city? Yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the Sabbath."

13:19 And it came to pass, that when the gates of Jerusalem began to be dark before the Sabbath, I commanded that the gates should be shut, and charged that they should not be opened till after the Sabbath: and some of my servants set I at the gates, that there should no burden be brought in on the Sabbath day.

It was customary to close the gate at night and opened when sun is hot (Neh 7:3).

The merchants came on the day before the Sabbath, arriving at the end of the day, so Nehemiah shut the gates on them. The evening was not the beginning of the new day or the Sabbath. As they lodge about the wall that evening, Nehemiah would not be laying his hands on them (v21) if it were the Sabbath. The Sabbath comes after dark, in the morning at sunrise. The merchants never made it into the city the evening of the day before the Sabbath, nor were they allowed in on the Sabbath day. Since the gates were closed at night, the merchants were kept out almost two days. From the evening of the day before the Sabbath to noon the day after the Sabbath.

SUNDAY LAWS

In Force in the Province of Ontario

PROHIBIT

1. **LABOR.** With certain exceptions this includes:

- (a) **THE WORK OF LABORERS, MECHANICS and MANUFACTURERS.**
- (b) **ALL FARM WORK,** such as SEEDING, HARVESTING, FENCING, DITCHING.
- (c) **WORK ON RAILWAYS,** such as BUILDING and CONSTRUCTION, and also REPAIR WORK, except in emergencies, and TRAFFIC, excepting the forwarding of PASSENGER AND CERTAIN FREIGHT TRAINS.
- (d) **ALL BUILDING, TEAMING, DRIVING FOR BUSINESS PURPOSES, THE WORK OF BAKERS and BARBERS, Etc.**
- (e) **THE WORK OF MUSICIANS and PAID PERFORMERS OF ANY KIND.** Works of necessity and mercy excepted.

2. **BUSINESS.** It is unlawful to MAKE CONTRACTS or to BUY, SELL or DELIVER ANYTHING on Sunday, including LIQUORS, CIGARS, NEWSPAPERS, Etc. Generally speaking the only exceptions are DELIVERING PASSENGERS' BAGGAGE, MILK for domestic use, and SUPPLYING MEALS and MEDICINES.

3. **ALL GAMES, RACES OR OTHER SPORTS FOR MONEY OR PRIZES,** or which are noisy, or at which a fee is charged, and the business of AMUSEMENT or ENTERTAINMENT.

4. **ALL EXCURSIONS** for hire and with the object of pleasure, by TRAIN, STEAMER or OTHER CONVEYANCE.

5. **ADVERTISING** in Canada, unlawful things to take place on Sunday, either in Canada or across the line.

6. **IMPORTING, SELLING or DISTRIBUTING FOREIGN NEWSPAPERS** on Sunday.

7. **ALL GAMBLING, TIPPLING, USING PROFANE LANGUAGE,** and all other acts which disturb the public quiet.

8. **ALL PUBLIC MEETINGS,** except in Churches.

9. **HUNTING, SHOOTING, FISHING;** also BATHING in any public place or in sight of a place of public worship, or private residence.

THE PENALTY IS FROM \$1.00 TO \$500.00

THE 5TH COMMANDMENT

HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER.

Exodus 20:12 ...that your days may be long upon the land which Yahweh your God giveth you.

Ephesians 6:2 Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with a promise;) That it may be well with you, and you might live long on the earth.

Matthew 15:5 But you scribes and Pharisees say, 'Whosoever says to his father or mother, "Whatever you may benefit from me has been dedicated", is certainly released from respecting his father or mother.'
15:6 So have you made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition (takanot).

The 5th Commandment was of a moral nature, had a promise of a long life, and was of an eternal obligation; of having respect towards your parents and to honor them in supplying them with their substance, food, clothing and the necessities of life. Jesus exposed the Jews who made void this command of God by their tradition (takanot). The law of God required that a son should honor his parents, and that he should provide for their needs when they were old and in distress. The 'gift' is a vow to God. Yet the Jewish tradition (takanot) said that it was more important for a man to dedicate his property, or his 'gift', to God, *or the temple priesthood*, than to provide for the needs of his parents.

THE 6TH COMMANDMENT

YOU SHALL NOT MURDER.

The 'letter' of the law.

Matthew 5:21 Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, You shalt not murder; and whosoever shall murder shall be in danger of the judgment:

The 'spirit' of the law.

5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, *Raca* (to insult, *an epithet*, an obscure term of abuse), shall be in danger of the council (Sanhedrin): but whosoever shall say, *You fool* (for no reason), shall be in danger of hell fire (to fire of GeHinnom).

Murder will receive judgment. Anger without a cause toward your brethren is worse.

If you call your brother a fool for no reason, you have become unclean, and you could be in grave danger.

We see three degrees of punishment, 'the judgment', 'the council', and 'hell-fire'. The judgment being judgment by God, which could have a degree of mercy to it. The council, would be by man's judgment, which may not include mercy. Hell-fire being the most severe, which would be condemnation and eternal death with no mercy.

Psalm 44:22 Yea, for Your sake are we killed all the day long; we are counted as sheep for the slaughter.

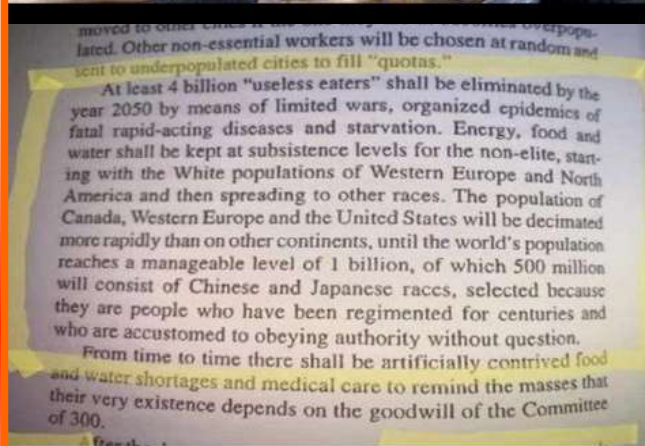

THE 7TH COMMANDMENT

1Corinthians 7:2

Jude 1:7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

Adultery occurs when a man has sexual relations with a woman who is married or betrothed to another man. The ancients knew adultery was sin. Gen 20:6-9 conversing with Abraham, Abimelech referred to adultery as a great sin. Gen 39:7-9 The master's wife looked with desire at Joseph and said, "Lie with me." But he refused and said to his master's wife, "How could I do this great evil and sin against God?" Joseph viewed adultery as a great evil. Job 24:15 The eye of the adulterer waits for the dusk, thinking, 'No one is watching us.' Job 31:9-11, "If my heart has been enticed by a woman, or I have lurked at my neighbor's door....it would be an iniquity." Having sex with a neighbor's wife is iniquity. Adultery also includes race mixing. Destroying the holy seedline and purity of the race of awdawn.

In the Latin Vulgate, **Exodus 20:14** was translated as *non moechaberis* and **Romans 13:9** as *non adulterabis*. Under the entry word *moicheuo*, in the *Theological Dictionary of the New Testament* the following definition is given: "of the intermingling of animals and men or of different races." This, of course, is the classical definition of *mongrelization*. So the Greek of the New Testament and the Greek Septuagint confirm that the translation "You will not mongrelize" is correct.

1Corinthians 5:1 It is commonly reported that there is fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so even named among the Nations, that one should have his father's wife.

Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous are His judgments: for He hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of His servants at her hand.

Deuteronomy 23:2 A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of Yahweh!

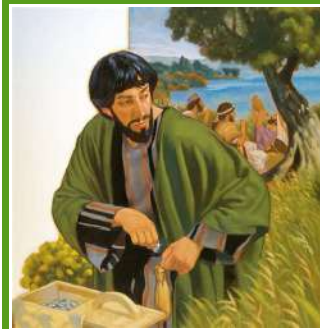

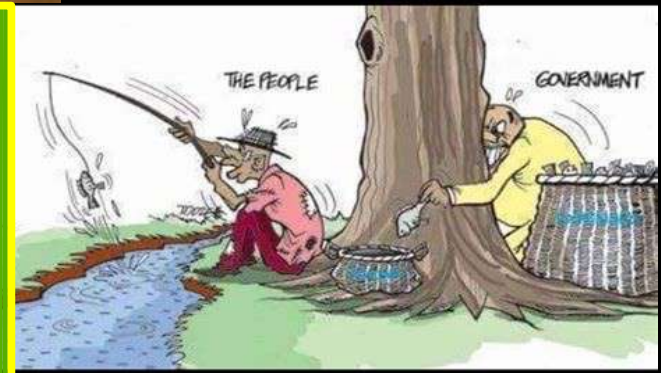

Thus the innocent blood was saved the same day.

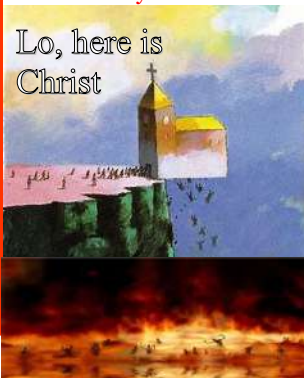

And Naboth said to Ahab, "Yahweh forbid it me, that I should give the inheritance of my fathers unto you."

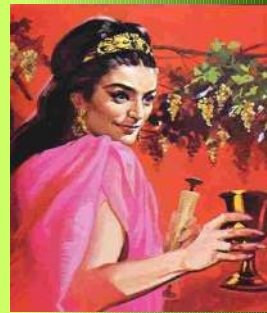

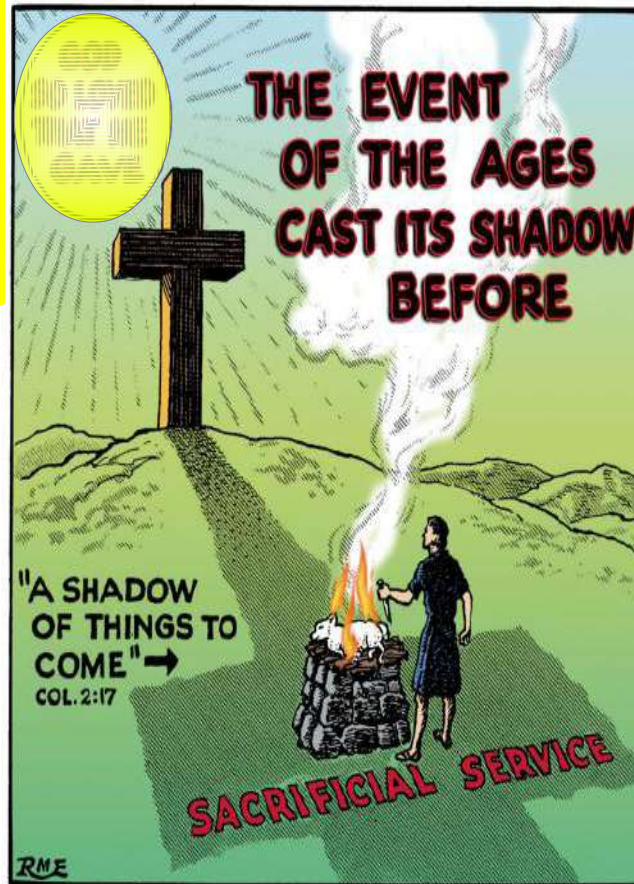
1John 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

Romans 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace. Being under the law simply means that we are under the design of mercy and the tendency of which is to subdue sin. This does not mean we are released from the obligation of the moral law, the commandments, statutes and judgments. 'Under the law' means 'in debt to the law', meaning having unpaid sentences from past judgements. Rather, we are under [in debt to] grace, for it was grace - not law - that forgave and redeemed us.

Galatians 3:23 But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed.

3:24 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

3:25 But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.



Hebrews 8:3 For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices:

8:5 Who serve unto the example (pattern) and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith He, *that* you make all things according to the pattern shewed to you in the mount.

The Levitical priesthood had to maintain a strict observance of every detail and follow it until the sacrifice of Christ.

The ceremonial law pointed out the guilt and punishment of sin; and was a type and shadow of deliverance by Jesus Christ, but it could not give the grace it shadowed.

The Purpose of the Law

Galatians 3:19 Then why the law of those *ordinances*?

It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made;

Yahweh promised Himself to the children of Israel in the form of Jesus The Christ, to fulfill the office of Mediator, and abolish the 'added' ritual practices of the Old Covenant.

This was the law unto which Paul declared he was dead, for that law which was added to the Commandments, Statutes and Judgments received by Israel at Mt. Sinai was none other than the "ORDINANCES".

Daniel 9:27 And He shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week He shall cause the **sacrifice and the oblation to cease**,

The phrase "sacrifice and the oblation to cease" refers to the Levitical priesthood and its ordinances.

This is what was 'done away with'.

The whole institution of the Levitical office which lasted 1600 years had served its purpose and has now expired because Jesus Yahshua Christ fulfilled all its ordinances, oblations, and purpose. Yahshua Christ is our High Priest.

No longer can men priests, rituals, blood sacrifices, and ceremonial oblations atone for your sins. To continue in them is to deny the work Jesus Christ fulfilled.

ANTINOMIANS ARE ACCURSED

The Spring Equinox is March 20, at 5:24 pm. When the sun rose (came out of his tabernacle) Month 1 Day 1 began.
Psalm 19:4 Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath He set a tabernacle for the sun, Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, *and* rejoiceth as a strong man to run a race.

The First Day of the Year in 2023 is March 20. The Sabbath day for this year is on Mondays.

The Sabbath begins at sunrise.

*I have recently learned that the Hebrew Day begins at sunrise. The sunset to sunset reckoning is Babylonian/Jewish/pagan. *I apologize for the error.*

PASSOVER is April 2. Passover is the preparation day for the following day which is the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread. The command to eat unleavened bread seven days begins in the evening of Passover until the evening of the seventh day of Unleavened Bread.

FEAST of UNLEAVENED BREAD begins April 3rd to the 9th. The first and seventh day of FUB are High Sabbaths.

FEAST of WEEKS is April 4. *The 50 day countdown to Pentecost begins.*

PENTECOST is May 23. A High Sabbath.

The Hebrew month is 30 days. The first 3 months are Spring time. Every third month is followed by a 91st day.

The 91st Days are Intercalary Days. They are seasonal markers following every 3rd month.

The first 91st day on June 18 marks the beginning of Summer time.

The second 91st day on September 17 marks the beginning of the Fall season.

FEAST of TRUMPETS is September 18. A High Sabbath.

DAY OF ATONEMENT is September 27. A High Sabbath. Your fast begins the evening of the 26th unto the evening of the 27th. No servile work to be done during the day, and your fast ends with a nice supper feast on the 27th.

FEAST of TABERNACLES begins October 2nd thru the 9th. An eight day Festival. The first and eighth day are High Sabbaths. The eighth day is **THE LAST GREAT DAY**.

The third 91st day on December 17 marks the beginning of the Winter season.

The fourth and last 91st day of the year is March 17. The last two days of the year are extra Sabbaths. Enjoy!

The Spring Equinox in 2024 is March 19 at 11:06pm. The Sun is in his tabernacle. When he rises out of his tabernacle at sunrise on the 20th he starts to run his new race. This will be the first day of the first month of the New Year.
