




Abraham spake unto the sons of Heth, saying...

Genesis 23:4 I am a stranger (H1616- gersojourner) and a sojourner (H8453- toshab) among you: give me a possession of a buryingplace among you, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.


Heth was Canaan's second son.
Abraham is a Hebrew. The children of Heth are Canaanites. Abraham is dwelling in the land of the Canaanites and is a sojourner and sojourning among them.

Genesis 17:8 And I will give unto you, and to your seed after you, the land wherein you art a stranger (H4033magur-land of pilgrimage), all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God. The land of Canaan was not Abraham's native land, so he and his seed after him were pilgrims and foreigners in the land.



Stephen reminds his kinsmen that Abraham was instructed by Yahweh to get away from his pagan kindred. And that Yahweh promised Abraham that his seed would inherit the land.

Automore And God spake on this wise, That his seed should sojourn (G3941- paroikos) in a strange (G245- allotrios-foreign) land (Egypt); and that the Egyptians should bring the Israelites into bondage, and entreat *them* evil for (about 80 years).



Hebrews 11:9 By (belief) he sojourned (G3939- paroikeo) in the land of promise, as in a strange country (G245- allotrios-alien, foreign), dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: (Gen 12:8, 35:27)
A strange country; which was not of his nativity, and not his own, but another's.

Exodus 12:19 Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger (H1616- ger-sojourner), or born (H249- ezrach-native) in the land.


The *ger* and *ezrach* are identifying both sojourning Israelites and Israelites born in the land. All Israelites are to observe the Passover

Numbers 9:14 And if a stranger (H1616- ger-sojourning kinsman) shall sojourn (H1481- gur-dwell) among you, and will keep the passover unto Yahweh; according to the ordinance of the passover, and according to the manner thereof, so shall he do: you shall have one ordinance, both for the stranger (H1616- ger-sojourning kinsman), and for him that was born (H249- ezrach-native) in the land.

Deuteronomy 16:11 And you shalt rejoice before Yahweh your God, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levite that *is* within your gates, and the stranger (H1616- ger-sojourning kinsman), and the fatherless, and the widow, that *are* among you, in the place which Yahweh your God hath chosen to place His name there.

16:14 And you shalt rejoice in your feast (of Weekscountdown to Pentecost), you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger (H1616-ger-sojourning kinsman), and the fatherless, and the widow, that *are* within your gates.

2Chronicles 30:25 And all the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers (H1616- ger-sojourning kinsmen) that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, rejoiced.









Exodus 12:43 And Yahweh said unto Moses and Aaron, This *is* the ordinance of the passover: There shall no stranger (H5236- nekar-son of the foreigner) eat thereof:

The Hebrew reads: "... There shall no son of a racial alien eat thereof".

12:44 But every man's servant (bondservant) that is bought for money, when you hast circumcised him, then shall he eat thereof.

These are bond servants or indentured servants that are kinsmen to the Israelites.

12:45 A foreigner (H8453- toshab-guest) and an hired servant shall not eat thereof.

The *toshab* was an unnaturalized sojourner, a temporary dweller, or guest (not just a visitor). Unlike proselytes, he wasn't fully a citizen in Israel's community. The *toshab* was uncircumcised, and therefore not authorized to eat the Passover (unlike the proselyte).

ger-proselyte) shall sojourn (H1481- gur-dwell as a guest) with you, and will keep the passover to Yahweh, let all his males be circumcised, and then let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as one that is born (H249- ezrach-native of) the land: for no uncircumcised person shall eat thereof.

The *ger* 'proselyte' is a converted kinsman. Foreigners, unknowns, and non-Israelites are not permitted to eat the Passover.

The Passover is an Israelite tradition and holy day.

Acts 2:5 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Judaeans, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

2:9 Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia,

2:10 Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers (G1927- epidemeo-sojourners, repatriated Romans) of Rome, Judaeans and proselytes,

2:11 Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.

The strangers of Rome were Repatriate Romans. Visitors from Rome. Repatriate means to restore or return to the country of origin, allegiance, or citizenship.

Roman sojourners - Born at Rome, but now living at Jerusalem.

The Parthians were a blend of Aramaic Shemites and Israelites.

The Medes and Elamites were descendants of Shem, so some Israelites dwelt among them.

The dwellers in Mesopotamia were the Israelites dwelling in that area.

Those in Judaea were Israelites of the house of Judah.

Those in Cappadocia in Pontus and Asia, Phrygia, and Pamphylia were Israelites. Those that migrated from that area and time became known as the Kimmerians, who later became Scythians, Celts and Germans.

The book of the Maccabees confirms Israelites of the house of Judah lived in Egypt, and as far as Libya and Cyrene.

The strangers of Rome reads 'repatriated Romans', which is a reference to war refugees. Many of the Romans were of the Zarah Judah branch of Israelites. There were Israelites on the island of Crete, and the Arabians were Israelites from the land of Arabia.

These events in Acts are the fulfillment of the prophecies given in the Old Testament, which were prophecies of and to the children of Israel. Specifically the prophecy of Joel 2:28-32 which is about Israelites receiving the Holy Spirit.



Acts 5:32 And we are His witnesses of these things; and also the Holy Spirit, whom God hath given to them that obey Him.

Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward, *that* I will pour out My spirit upon <u>all flesh</u>; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: (Zec 12:10) 2:29 And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out My spirit.

We see in both Ezekiel and in Joel that the promise of that latter rain of the Spirit marking our full restoration does not come until the time of the destruction of our enemies. By "all flesh" here the Word of God can only mean "all Adamic flesh" (Anglo-Saxon Israelites), which is evident from reading Isaiah.

Isaiah 44:1-3

Yet now hear, O Jacob My servant; and Israel, whom I have chosen:

Thus saith Yahweh that made you, and formed you from the womb, which will help you; Fear not, O Jacob, My servant; and you, Jesurun (upright), whom I have chosen.

For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour My spirit upon your seed, and My blessing upon your offspring:



1Peter 2:11 Dearly beloved, I beseech *you* as strangers (G3941- paroikos-temporary residents, sojourners) and pilgrims (G3927-parepidemos-expatriates), abstain from fleshly lusts (desires), which war against the soul; (Psa 39:12; Gal 5:16; Jas 4:1)

These 'strangers and pilgrims/sojourners' 'paroikos and parepidemos' in all these verses in Ephesians, along with Hebrews 11:13, 1Peter 2:9, 11, are all descendants of the BC Israelites who were the 'strangers and pilgrims/sojourners' 'ger and toshab' in Genesis 23:4, Leviticus 25:23,35,47, Numbers 35:15, 1Chronicles 29:15 and Psalm 39:12.

In other words, the strangers and pilgrims in the OT and in the NT are none other than Israelites.

Hebrews 11:13 These all died in faith (according to belief), not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, welcomed and embraced *them*, and confessed that they were strangers (G3581- xenos-lodgers, travelers) and pilgrims (G3927- parepidemosresident foreigners, expatriates) on the earth. (Gen 23:4; 1Chr 29:15; Psa 39:12; Heb 11:39)

John 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day: and he saw, and was glad.

Strangers is xenos, an adjective, and means foreign, a guest or entertainer, host. A traveler.


So Abraham to the children of Heth (Gen 23:4-ger-H1616 and toshab-H8453); and Jacob to Pharaoh (Gen 47:9-magur-H4033-pilgrimage; Psa 119:19-ger-H1616). *Pilgrims* is *parepidemos*, adjective, and means an alien alongside, resident foreigner-pilgrim.

We are foreigners and pilgrims on the earth. *Parepidemos* is the compound of the verb *epidemeo* G1927 (seen only in Acts 2:10, 17:21), meaning "to be among people."

1Chronicles 29:13 Now therefore, our God, we thank You, and praise Your glorious name.

29:14 But who *am* I, and what *is* my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly after this? for all things come from You, and we have given You out of Your hand.







Hospitality is *philonexia*, a noun fem, and means hospitableness, entertain strangers, love to strangers.

Pursue hospitality - Not only embracing those that offer, but seeking opportunities to exercise it. "Pursuing", or "following after love to strangers" as Abraham and Lot did, who thereby entertained angels unawares, and is what the apostle here means by pursuing and following after it.



Hebrews 13:1 Let brotherly love continue. 13:2 Be not forgetful to entertain strangers (G5381- philonexia, hospitality, fond-lodging): for thereby some have entertained angels (divine messengers) unawares. (Gen 18:1-8, 19:1-3; Tob 5:4-5)

Matthew 25:35 For I was an hungred, and you gave Me meat: I was thirsty, and you gave Me drink: I was a stranger (xenos -sojourning kinsman – ger in the OT), and you took Me in:

Leviticus 16:29 And this shall be a statute for ever unto you: that in the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, you shall afflict your souls (by fasting), and do no work at all, whether it be one of your own country (H249- ezrach-native), or a stranger (H1616- gersojourner) that sojourneth (H1481- gur-abides, dwells as a guest) among you:

The ger stranger in this context are Israelite sojourners.
The Day of Atonement is a day of repentance and fasting.
Only Israelites were given the law and need cleansing for breaking the law.
These statutes for the DOA and Jubilee do not apply to non-Israelites.

The first time the Liberty Bell in America was rung, was not for the reading of the Declaration of Independence. It was rung 20 years earlier which was to call the councilmen in Philadelphia to vote to print their own money in defiance of the Crown in England.

Why didn't New JerUS Alem keep the Jubilee Year of Release?

We let the Jewish *strangers* control the money system!



Leviticus 25:9 Then shalt you cause the trumpet of the jubilee (sound of ram's horns) to sound on the tenth *day* of the seventh month, in the day of atonement (propitiation) shall you make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

The Jubilee starts on the Day of Atonement in the 49th year and lasts until the Day of Atonement the following year. Example: 49 years. The '50th year is symbolic. This Yobel year would be within the 49th and 50th year. The next Yobel year would be within the 98th and 99th year. 147th and 148th, etc. 25:10 And you shall hallow the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout *all* the land unto all the inhabitants thereof: it shall be a jubilee unto you; and you shall return every man unto his possession, and you shall return every man unto his family.









In Luke chapter 4 we see Jesus come into Nazareth and go into the synagogue on the sabbath. And there was delivered unto Him the book of Isaiah and He read:

Isaiah 61:1 "The Spirit of Yahweh GOD *is* upon Me; because Yahweh hath anointed Me to preach good tidings unto the meek; He hath sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD."

What is the acceptable year of the Lord?

The key word in Isaiah is 'liberty'. To proclaim liberty to the captives.

If you look back at Leviticus 25:10 you read 'And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof: it shall be a jubilee unto you; and ye shall return every man unto his possession, and ye shall return every man unto his family.'

Our God is waiting for us to preach and keep the acceptable year of Yahweh. But the 'churches' teach us to remain in captivity and debt by teaching our people that His laws, commandments, statutes and judgments were 'done away with'.

Notice what Jesus did after He read Isaiah 61:2, 'He closed the book, and He gave it again to the minister, and sat down.' Jesus passed the teaching and instruction to the minister and then sat down. This signified that the job of the ministers is to continue preaching about this, which they don't.

Deuteronomy 16:13 You shalt observe the feast of tabernacles seven days, after that you hast gathered in your corn (grain) and your wine:

16:14 And you shalt rejoice in your feast, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger (H1616- gersojourning kinsman), and the fatherless, and the widow, that *are* within your gates.



Acts 13:16 Then Paul stood up, and beckoning with his hand said, Men of Israel, you that fear God, give audience.

13:17 The God of this people of Israel chose our fathers, and exalted the people when they dwelt as strangers (G3940-paroikia-in their sojourn) in the land of Egypt, and with an high arm brought He them out of it. (Exo 1:7, 12:51)

Strangers is G3940 paroikia, noun fem, and means foreign residence, sojourning, dwelling in a strange land.



Psalm 119:18 Open You mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of Your law.

119:19 I *am* a stranger (H1616- ger-sojourner) in the earth (land): hide not Your commandments from me.

119:54 Your statutes have been my songs in the house of my pilgrimage (H4033- magur).

David considered his life as a journey.

Hebrews 11:13 These all died in belief, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. In their unsettled state, sojourning, being away from their land, the court, the palace, and wherever they sojourned, our ancestors always relied on Yahweh and His Torah.

1Peter 1:15 But as He which hath <u>called you</u> is holy, so be you holy in all manner of conversation (conduct);
1:16 Because it is written, Be you holy; for I am holy. (Lev 11:44, 19:2, 20:26)

1:17 And if you call on the Father, who without respect of persons (without partiality) judgeth according to every man's work, you must conduct yourselves in fear for the time of your sojourning (G3940- paroikia) here in fear:

Psalm 146:8 Yahweh openeth *the eyes of* the blind: Yahweh raiseth them that are bowed down: Yahweh loveth the righteous: **146:9** Yahweh preserveth the strangers (H1616- gersojourners); He relieveth the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked He turneth upside down.

146:10 Yahweh shall reign for ever, *even* your God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise you Yahweh.

Proverbs 2:16 To deliver you from the strange (H2114-zur-estranged, harlot) woman, *even* from the stranger (H5237- nokriy-adulterer) *which* flattereth with her words; **2:17** Which forsaketh the guide of her youth, and forgetteth the covenant of her God.

Zur means to be strange, become estranged, alienated, another, to be foreign, a harlot, profane.

Nokriy means strange, in a variety of degrees and applications (foreign(er), non-relative, adulterous, different):-alien, outlandish.

Zur 'strange women' because she belongs to another person, and not to him whom she entices into her embraces.


These verses are talking about estranged women, or harlots, or adulterers. They can also be referring to racially alien women, but in verse 17 she 'forsakes her youth' and 'forgets the covenant of her God'. So verse 16 would be talking about estranged Israelite harlot women.

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life:
6:24 To keep you from the evil woman, from the flattery of the tongue of a strange (H5237- nokriy-adulterous, foreign) woman.

Proverbs 22:14 The mouth of strange (H2114- zur-harlot, alien, profane) women *is* a deep pit: he that is abhorred of Yahweh shall fall therein.

This can be interpreted as idolatry, fair words and false doctrines, lies, trannies, vpocrisy, fornication, sorceries





Ezra 9:2 For they have taken of their daughters for themselves, and for their sons: so that the <u>holy seed have mingled</u> themselves with the people of *those* lands: yea, the hand of the princes and rulers hath been chief in this trespass.

Nehemiah 13:26 Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? yet among many nations was there no king like him, who was beloved of his God, and God made him king over all Israel: nevertheless even him did outlandish (H5237- nokriy-foreign) women cause to sin.

Note: The 'strange woman' can also be 'strange doctrine'. 'Defiled with women', meaning defiled by **False religion**.

Revelation 14:4 These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever He goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.

Revelation 3:4 Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not <u>defiled</u> their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white: for they are worthy.

Garments is symbolic of righteousness.



1Kings 11:1 But king Solomon loved many strange (H5237- nokriy-foreign) women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, *and* Hittites; 11:2 Of the nations *concerning* which Yahweh said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall not go in to them, neither shall they come in unto you: *for* surely they will turn away your heart after their gods: Solomon clave unto these in love.

11:8 And likewise did he for all his strange (H5237-nokriy-racially foreign) wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods.

Nokriy, here means foreign, non-relative, alien, foreigner, outlandish

Exodus 20:14 and Romans 13:9

Under the entry word *moicheuo* (adultery) the following definition is given: "of the intermingling of animals and men or of different races."

This, of course, is the classical definition of *mongrelization*. So the Greek of the New Testament and the Greek Septuagint confirm that the translation "You will not *mongrelize*" is correct.

Septuagint: "...I am the son of an Amalekite sojourner."

1:14 And David said unto him, How wast you not afraid to stretch forth your hand to destroy Yahweh's anointed?

1:15 And David called one of the young men, and said, Go near, and fall upon him. And he smote him that he died.

1:16 And David said unto him, Thy blood be upon your head; for your mouth hath testified against you, saying, I have slain Yahweh's anointed.

Why did David slay him? He slayed Saul, and because the Amalekites are descendants of Esau, and because....

Exodus 17:16 For he said, Because Yahweh hath sworn that Yahweh will have war with Amalek from generation to generation.



John 10:1 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that enters not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way,



Strangers is *allotrios*, and means another, not ones own, foreign, not akin, hostile:-alien. The Greek has 'other placed ones'.

The Jewish Pharisees then, and false pastors today, are indeed 'other placed ones', aliens, because they are not the ones that are supposed to be in those positions.

the same is a thief and a robber. But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out. And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice. 10:5 And a stranger (G245- allotriosan alien) will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers (G245- allotriosaliens). This parable spake Yahshua unto them: but they (the Jewish Pharisees) understood not what things they were which He spake unto them.

The identity and status of the "strangers" in the Bible **CANNOT** be interpreted by assumption or by a universal application of one definition.

We need to determine *which word* is being used — and *the context in which it is used* — in order to determine the person's identity and relationship to Israel.

Ruth 2:10 Then she fell on her face, and bowed herself to the ground, and said unto him, Why have I found grace in your eyes, that you shouldest take knowledge of me, seeing I *am* a stranger (H5237- nokriy/xenos G3581 -a foreign one)?

Notice that Ruth stated that she was a *nokriy*. Ruth was mistaken about her identity. Just like in the 'churches'!

Ruth was a native of Moab, which was cleansed of Moabites 400 years earlier. (Num 21:25-29)

If Ruth were not an Israelite, then she would not have been redeemed by Boaz.

Fulfilling the law found in Deuteronomy 25:6 in which their firstborn would bear the name of Ruth's dead husband, that his name be not put out of Israel.

And so, King David and Jesus Christ were not Moabites!



2Samuel 15:19 Then said the king to Ittai the Gittite, Wherefore goest you also with us? return to your place, and abide with the king: for you are a stranger (H5237- nokriyforeigner), and an exile. Whereas you camest *but* yesterday, should I this day make you go up and down with us? seeing I go whither I may, return you, and take back your brethren: mercy and truth *be* with you. And Ittai answered the king, and said, *As* Yahweh liveth, and

as my lord the king liveth, surely in what place my lord the king shall be, whether in death or life, even there also

will your servant be.

Ittai the Gittite was a non-native Israelite, as was Ruth.

David would not have had a band of 600 nokriy aliens at his side.

The stranger (G241 allogenes, is a tribal subdivision within a nation having the same ancestor) who was one of the ten lepers in Luke 17 who turned back and glorified Jesus for healing him, and in Luke 10 this Samaritan who helped the man that was left for dead, was no doubt an allogenes Israelite.




Neighbor in the OT is H7453 *rea/reya*, and means brother. H5997 *amiyth*, means relation, kindred. Brother in the NT is G80 *adelphos*, and means of the same womb, of the same national ancestry.

'Neighbour' was to be a 'brother', as we see in Deuteronomy 15:2-3 where we are commanded to grant our 'neighbour-brothers' release from debts every seventh year. In Leviticus 19:18 we are taught how to treat our 'neighbour-brothers'. In Zechariah 3:10 we see a vision of 'the refreshing of neighborliness under the vine and under the fig tree'.

Vine is symbolic of Israelites. Fig tree is symbolic of Israelites of the house of Judah.

Exodus 22:21 You shalt neither vex (treat violently) a stranger (H1616- gersojourner), nor oppress him: for you were strangers (ger, sojourners) in the land of Egypt. (Lev 19:33-34 Deut 24:17-18 27:19)

The remembrance of this should move their compassion to the sojourning kinsman, and would serve to abate their pride and vanity.



The priest was not an indicator of race in first century Judaea, but only indicated status, which Jesus consistently censured the Jewish priests who were Edomites, impostors, and not children of Abraham. The priest would represent the moral law.

The Levite that passed by would represent the ceremonial law; and so by both the priest and the Levite, represented the whole law of Moses; and intimates, that no mercy is to be expected from those who were sitting in Moses' seat of authority, which at that time were the Jewish Pharisees and Sadducees that did not follow the law but kept their own traditions.

Zechariah 7:9 Thus speaketh Yahweh of hosts, saying, Execute true judgment, and shew mercy (loving-commitment) and (deep) compassions every man to his brother: 7:10 And oppress not the widow, nor the fatherless, the stranger (H1616- ger-sojourner) (sojourning kinsmen), nor the poor; and let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart.

Ger is a sojourner. In the context, an Israelite sojourning guest, a kinsman foreigner.

The widow, the fatherless, the poor, and the stranger, are Israelites and kindred peoples, hence 'let none of you imagine evil against his <u>brother</u> in your heart.

Brother is H251 *ach*, and means kindred, relative, same tribe.

Ephesians 2:12 That at that time you were without (apart from) Christ (the Anointedgroup), being aliens (G526- apallotrioo- having been alienated, estranged) from the commonwealth (citizenship) of Israel, and strangers (G3581- xenos-adjective-lodgers, guests-without the knowledge) from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:

2:13 But now in Christ Yahshua you who sometimes were <u>far off</u> are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

'You who were far off' are those Israelites of the scattered 10 tribes that migrated elsewhere after the Assyrian invasion.

The blood of The Christ and the promises are to all Israelites. (Gal 3:28; Acts 2:39) **2:14** For He is our peace, who hath made <u>both</u> one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition *between us;*

This is the two sticks prophecy. The middle wall is the ignorance and hostility of the flesh. The 2 houses of Judah and Israel were united through the Gospel. Judah (the circumcised) and Israel (the uncircumcised).

2:15 Having abolished in His flesh the enmity, *even* the law of commandments *contained* in ordinances (dogmas); for to make in Himself of twain one new man, *so* making peace; (Col 2:14,20; Act 11:1-3)

2:16 And that He might reconcile <u>both</u> unto God in one <u>body</u> by the cross, having slain the enmity (hostility) thereby:

The 2 Houses of Judah and Israel forgot who they were and had hostility between themselves. The Judaeans had the law and the dispersed did not. The Judaeans viewed the dispersed Israelite Nations as 'common' or profane. They did not know they were also of the anointed seed of Jacob and kindred relations.

2:17 And came and preached peace to you which were <u>afar off</u> (dispersed Israel), and to them that were nigh (near, Judaean Israel).

These verses are OT prophecies about Israelites being fulfilled in their AD descendants.

Isaiah 57:19 I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near, saith Yahweh; and I will heal him.

Psalm 148:14 He also exalteth the horn of His people, the praise of all His saints of the children of Israel, a people <u>near</u> unto Him. Praise you Yahweh.

2:18 For through Him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

2:19 Now therefore you are no more strangers (G3581- xenos-without knowledge) and foreigners (G3941- paroikos-temporary residents, sojourners), but fellowcitizens (G4847-sumpolites) with the <u>saints</u>, and of the household (G3609- oikeios-family members) of God; (Rom 11:17-24; Isa 14:1)

Both houses are no more strangers to each other, both houses are Abraham's seed, both houses are saints (called).

No more ignorant of, and without a share in, the reconciliation of the *oikeios* of God. The northern house of Israel became ignorant of their heritage and God. These were those Israelites that did not return to Judaea after captivity and went elsewhere. It was these *xenos*-strangers and *paroikos*-foreigners that Paul preached the gospel to. To remind them who they were and of their inheritance.

These 'strangers and pilgrims/sojourners' in all these verses in Ephesians, along with Hebrews 11:13, 1Peter 2:9, 11, are all descendants of the BC Israelites who were the 'strangers and pilgrims/sojourners' in Genesis 23:4, Leviticus 25:23,35,47, Numbers 35:15, 1Chronicles 29:15 and Psalm 39:12.

In other words, the strangers and pilgrims in the OT and in the NT are none other than Israelites.

Colossians 1:21 And you (dispersed of Israel), that were sometime alienated (G526- apallotrioo- estranged) and enemies in *your* mind (thoughts) by wicked works, Alienated is G526 *apallotrioo*, a verb, and means to estrange away, alienate, be alien. Shut out from one's fellowship and intimacy.

Our ancestors were alienated because of their wicked works and Yahweh divorced them and scattered them among the nations. Their children would grow up outside the commonwealth of Israel because the house of Israel was no longer a nation after the Assyrian invasion and deportation. These Israelites were walking in darkness among the nations and forgot who they were, Whose they were.







and means an alien alongside, resident foreigner- pilgrim.

The compound of the verb epidemeo G1927, meaning "to be among people."

The Greek renders it correctly as 'to chosen expatriates of thru-sowing'.

This is because when our ancestors were scattered among the nations they forgot who they were and Whose they were. This was by Yahweh's design, a type of sowing, like in the parable of the sower. Our ancestors were divorced from Yahweh and living among the nations in ignorance. Their descendants, when the Gospel caught up to them, grew into Christians.

Judges 10:13 Yet ye have forsaken Me, and served other gods: wherefore I will deliver you no more.

10:14 Go and cry unto the gods which ye have chosen; let them deliver you in the time of your tribulation (affliction, adversity).
10:15 And the children of Israel said unto Yahweh, We have sinned: do You unto us whatsoever seemeth good unto You; deliver us only, we pray You, this day.



Strange in verse 18 and strangers in verse 21 is xenos, an adjective, and means foreign (literally alien, or figuratively novel). Without the knowledge of. New, unheard of. A traveler.

Verse 18 is an unheard of or unknown god. To these pagan Athenians, and today's 'churches' is Yahshua The Christ. Verse 21 are travelers, lodgers, and guests.



They were philosophers. The strangers were foreigners and guests.

In verse 20 *strange* is G3579 *xenizo*, a verb, and means to be a host, entertain, lodge, (think it) strange, be shocked.

Athens was greatly distinguished for the celebrity of its schools of philosophy. It was at that time at the head of the literary world. Its arts and its learning were celebrated in all lands. It is known, therefore, that it was the favorite resort of people of other nations, who came there to become acquainted with its institutions and to listen to its sages.

The 'churches' would be saying the same things if the truth was Being told to them.

They'd be saying "You are bringing into the hearing of us, certain things being strange to our ears." "What do you mean the law wasn't done away with?" "Jesus wasn't a Jew?" "There is no rapture?" "And we shouldn't eat bacon!?"

Psalm 137:4 How shall we sing Yahweh's song in a strange (H5236- nekar-foreign)(NT G245 allotrios) land? Strange being a foreign land. Referring to the time in Babylon. And today in Mystery Babylon. Strange is H5236 nekar, a noun, and means foreign, alien. Different.





Hebrews 13:9 Be not carried about with diverse and strange (G3581- xenos-entertaining) doctrines. For *it is* a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with foods, by which those who walk have no advantage. We have an altar from which to eat; they serving the tabernacle have no authority.

The reference is to the Judaizing teachers and pastors, and to their various doctrines about their ceremonial observances and traditions, and denominational beliefs of churchianity. The 'altar' refers to the cross on which the great sacrifice was made. Paul is stating that there is a higher and more valuable sacrifice of which the Judaizers and false pastors have no right to partake in.

Strange is xenos, an adjective, and means foreign, an entertainer, host. Without the knowledge of, without a share in. New, unheard of. Entertaining doctrines.

Is Judeo-Christianity not an entertaining doctrine?
God loves everybody, you can declare yourself 'saved' OSAS, free rapture tickets for 'just believing', eat pork, race-mix, the law was 'done away with' so you're under grace, and you become Abraham's seed and a spiritual Israelite when you accept Jesus, and you will have a mansion and a fruit basket waiting for you in the heavenly suburbs in the clouds.

1Peter 4:3 For the time past of *our* life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the heathens (nations), when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings (orgies), banquetings (wild parties), and abominable idolatries: Wherein they think it strange (G3579- xenizo-shocking, surprising) that you run not with *them* to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of *you*: 4:12 Beloved, think it not strange (G3579- xenizo-foreign, surprising) concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing (G3581- xenos- unusual matter) happened unto you:

Strange is G3579 xenizo, a verb, and means to be a host, entertain, lodge, (think it) strange, be shocked or surprised. Strange thing is xenos, and means foreign. New, unheard of.

Sometimes we are surprised when we are being judged. The apostle in this verse returns to his former argument, to animate and encourage the saints in suffering afflictions patiently for righteousness sake.

Psalm 19:4 Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath He set a tabernacle for the sun, Which *is* as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, *and* rejoiceth as a strong man to run a race.

The 2024 Spring Equinox is March 19 at 11:06pm.

The Sun is in his tabernacle. When he rises out of his tabernacle at sunrise on the 20th he starts to run his new race.

The First Day of the Year in 2024 is March 20. The Sabbath day for this year is on Wednesdays.

The Sabbath begins at sunrise.

PASSOVER is April 2. Passover is the preparation day for the following day, the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread. The command to eat unleavened bread for seven days begins in the evening of Passover until the evening of the seventh day of Unleavened Bread.

FEAST of UNLEAVENED BREAD begins April 3rd to the 9th. The first and seventh day of FUB are High Sabbaths. **FEAST of WEEKS** is April 4. **The 50 day countdown to Pentecost begins**.

PENTECOST is May 23. A High Sabbath.

The Hebrew month is 30 days. The first 3 months are Spring time. Every third month is followed by a 91 st day.

The 91st Days are Intercalary Days. They are seasonal markers following every 3rd month.

The first 91st day on June 18 marks the beginning of Summer time.

The second 91st day on September 17 marks the beginning of the Fall season.

FEAST of TRUMPETS is September 18. A High Sabbath.

DAY OF ATONEMENT is September 27. A High Sabbath. Your fast begins the evening of the 26th unto the evening of the 27th.

No servile work to be done during the day, and your fast ends with a nice supper feast on the 27th.

FEAST of TABERNACLES begins October 2nd thru the 9th. An eight day Festival. The first and eighth days are High Sabbaths.

The eighth day is **THE LAST GREAT DAY**.

The third 91st day on December 17th marks the beginning of the Winter season.

The fourth and last 91st day of the year is March 18.
